About LOV2030

LOV2030 brings together people, organisations and ideas to reflect on the future of Leuven and the East Brabant region. We believe that art and culture, drawing on the power of imagination, can contribute to a new vision of the future centred on a just and sustainable way of living together. We want to involve young people and students more closely in this vision and are looking for enthusiastic interns who will help make a difference.

To assess the impact, LOV2030 is conducting an impact study in collaboration with IDEA Consult and various partners, as described in the [bid book](#). From September 2026 to March 2027, we will carry out a baseline assessment to gain an understanding of the current state of Leuven and the East Brabant region in relation to the four impact ambitions and their corresponding intended outcomes.

What will you be doing?

- Contribute to the development and implementation of the baseline assessment as a key foundation for the impact study.
- Support the preparation and follow-up of monitoring activities, surveys, questionnaires and the collection of information and data from various sources.
- Help organise meetings, presentations and working sessions with partners, in collaboration with the LOV2030 team and IDEA Consult.
- Contribute substantively during meetings and brainstorming sessions, thereby helping to shape the programme.
- Help develop presentations (e.g. PowerPoint) and translate content into clear visual formats.

Who are we looking for?

- You have a keen interest in the impact of art and culture, and in how these relate to social issues.
- You are independent, but also enjoy working as part of a team.
- You are good at planning and organising and are proficient with digital tools (such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Miro, etc.).
- You are creative, curious and eager to learn.
- You preferably speak Dutch and can also express yourself fluently in English.

What do we offer?

- A unique opportunity to gain experience within a large-scale cultural project with an international reach.
- Close collaboration with a small, driven team, as well as with numerous artists and (international) partners.
- Opportunities to take the initiative and contribute your own ideas.
- An internship in Leuven, with the option of hybrid working.
- Only long-term internship placements as part of a study programme will be considered.
